

YOUR CRUISE PROGRAM

Day 1 GREENOCK (GLASGOW), SCOTLAND (D)

Embarkation at 16:00 pm - 17:00 pm. | Departure 18:00 pm

Day 2 TOBERMORY, ISLE OF MULL (B/L/D)

Located at the northernmost tip of the lovely Isle of Mull, Tobermory has to be one of the most beautiful natural seaports on Scotland's West Coast. This ancient fishing village has been converted to a leisure port

Day 3 LOCH EWE & SAILING ALONG SHIANT ISLANDS. (B/L/D)

Loch Ewe, located in the Northwest Highlands, is a sea loch surrounded by mountains, looking out onto the North Atlantic. Visit A day to visit the loch shelters a remarkable botanic garden, Inverewe Garden. It is now managed by the National Trust for Scotland.

(Loch Ewe) A veritable paradise for observing seabirds and marine mammals, the archipelago offers magnificent scenery. Puffins, guillemots and razorbills find refuge in the cliffs here, co-existing with fulmars and black-legged kittiwakes. White-tailed eagles soar above inaccessible cliffs. As for the seals, they gather around rocky formations.

Day 4 SAINT KILDA, HEBRIDES (B/L/D)

St Kilda is an archipelago of seven volcanic islands, located 35 nautical miles west of the Outer Hebrides. They are the most remote of the British Isles. It is the only site in the United Kingdom to hold joint UNESCO World Heritage Site status for both its natural and cultural qualities.

Day 5 FOULA, SHETLAND ISLANDS (B/L/D)

Foula, lying some twenty nautical miles west of the Shetlands, is the archipelago's most remote island as well as one of the most remote inhabited British islands: Here lies island rock measures 12.5 km² (4.8 square miles) with high cliffs, the largest of which reach 365 m (almost 1,200 feet)

Day 6 SUDUROY ISLAND (B/L/D)

Suduroy Island, literally "South Island", has one of the smallest populations in the Faroe Islands. It has sheer cliffs along its western face. The island is an important breeding ground for seabirds, including northern fulmars, black-legged kittiwakes, Atlantic puffins, and guillemots (**INCLUDED : Choice of 3 shore excursions**)

Day 7 STREYMOY ISLAND (B/L/D)

Streymoy Island is the largest and most populated of the Faroe Islands, with 22,500 inhabitants. Lying between Scotland and Iceland, the 18-island Danish archipelago boasts natural wonders that will **fascinate lovers of the great outdoors**. Here, the hilly green landscapes stand in contrast with the huge basalt cliffs and the invigorating air shifts with the moods of the ocean

Day 8 STORNOWAY, HEBRIDES (B/L/D)

Discover Lewis, the largest island of the Hebrides, considered to be the cradle of Gaelic culture, Not far from Stornoway, the island's main town, built by the Vikings in the 9th century stands one of Scotland's most prominent prehistoric sites: **The Standing Stones of Callanish**. Dating back to more than 3,000 years B.C.

Day 9 FORT WILLIAMS, (B,L,D)

Fort William is sometimes described as the "Outdoor Capital of the UK." Because it sits at the base of Ben Nevis, the highest peak in the British Isles,, it is a popular destination for hikers. Included Hiking available for guests. For those looking for a less adventurous experience, the nearby Ben Nevis Distillery offers tours and tastings, and Old Fort and Old Inverlochy Castle are interesting historical sites.
